

Kunde garners 'Special' honor

BRIDGMAN - Bee basketball player Dan Kunde was named Special Mention on this year's Associated Press Class C All-State basketball team.

The 6-foot-7 senior forward averaged 14.3 points, 12 rebounds and three assists per game for the 21-2 Bees, rated No. 4 in the final Class C poll.

Kunde helped lead Bridgman to back-to-back Lakeland Conference championships. Special mention honorees are those players not named to the first team, but who received two or more votes from the 10-member selection panel.



Bridgman teams posted a 54-13 record during Kunde's three years as a starter.

“Dan was a major part of all that, and a major part of our back-to-back Lakeland Conference championships,” said Bee coach Mike Miller, who was picked as an Honorable Mention coach of the year. “He was our top rebounder last year and this year.”

Kunde has had numerous offers from various [NCAA and] NAIA schools, according to Miller, but [is still undecided].
